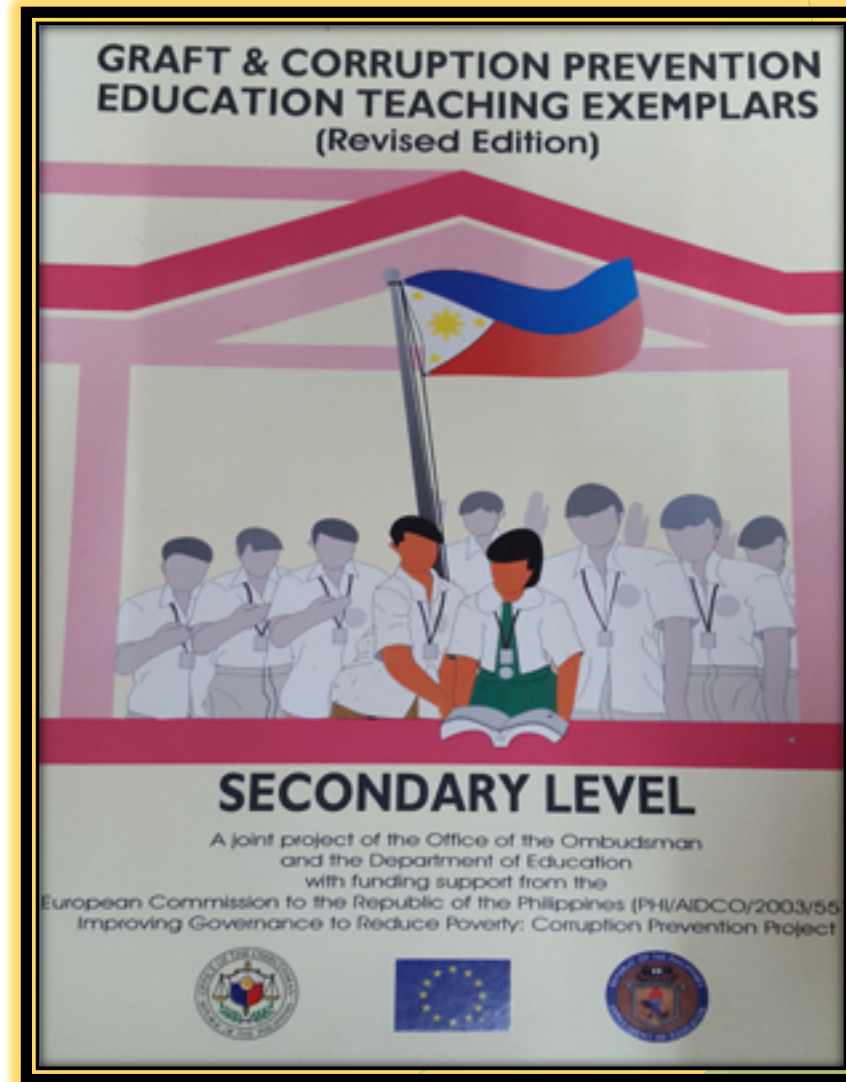
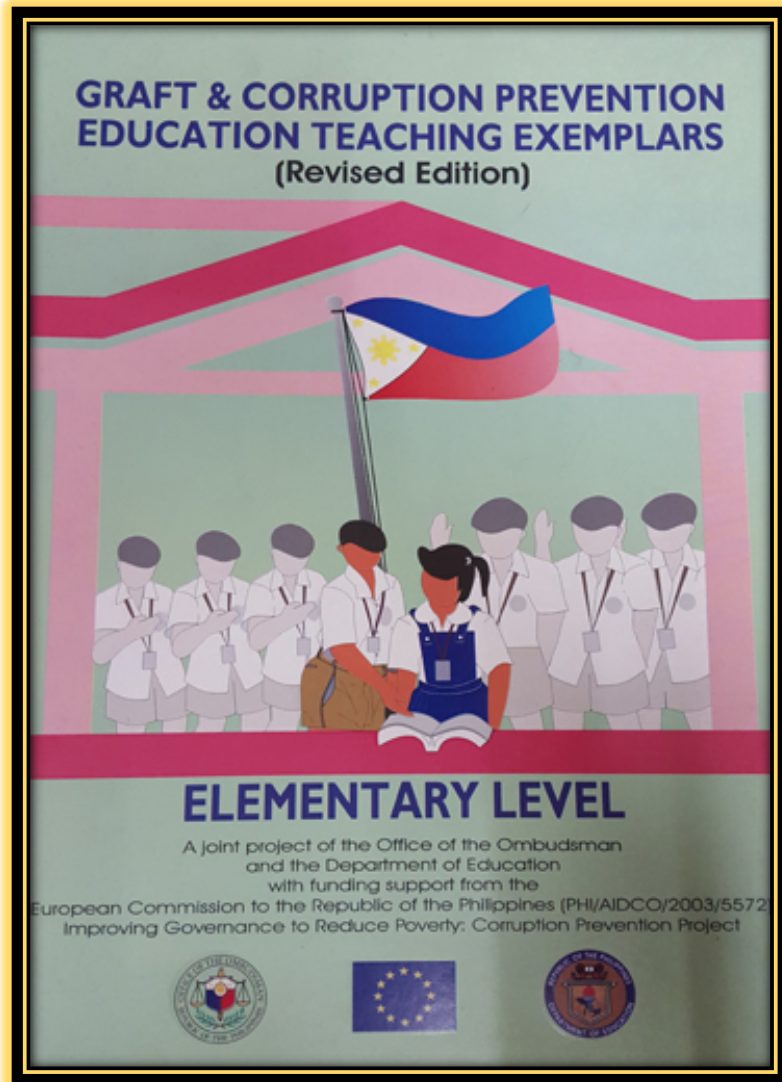




GRAFT AND CORRUPTION PREVENTION EDUCATION TEACHING EXEMPLARS



- 
- A set of guides for use of all primary and secondary teachers in public schools nationwide.
 - Designed to instill honesty, integrity and public service among the elementary and high school students.

- Integrates the norms of conduct enumerated in Republic Act No. 6713, or the *Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards for Public Officials and Employees*.

- Commitment to public interest
- Professionalism
- Justness and sincerity
- Political neutrality
- Responsiveness to the public
- Nationalism and patriotism
- Commitment to democracy
- Simple living

- Focuses on building (personal) honesty, integrity, discipline, dignity, simple living and competence.
- Revised in 2004 to conform to the new Basic Education Curriculum of DepEd.
- Revised edition now consists of 52 modules (elementary and secondary)



EC-OMB Corruption Prevention Project (JANUARY 2007)

- Provided grant assistance for the printing of 200,000 copies of the Revised Teaching Exemplars.



Millennium Challenge Account-Philippine Threshold Program- Technical Assistance Project (MCA-PTP-TAP) (2007-2008)

- Provided grant assistance for the distribution to the 44,000 public elementary and secondary schools nationwide.
- The distribution was made possible through the 2,462 District and Division offices of the DepEd.



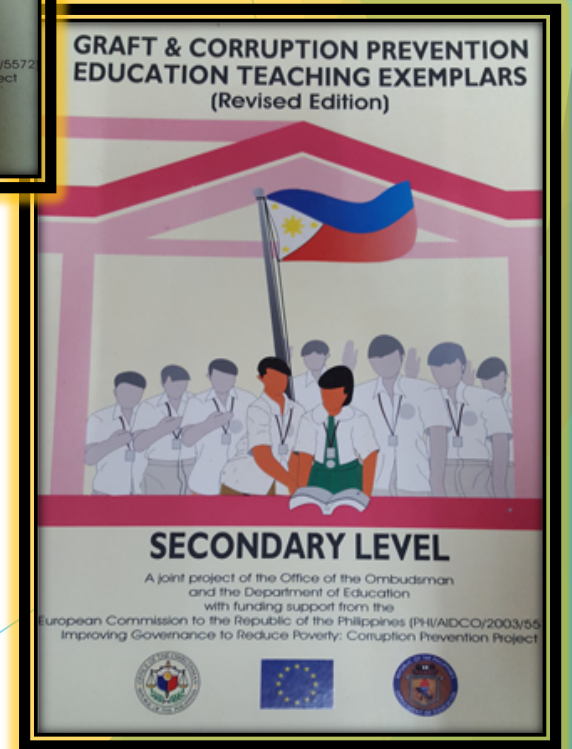
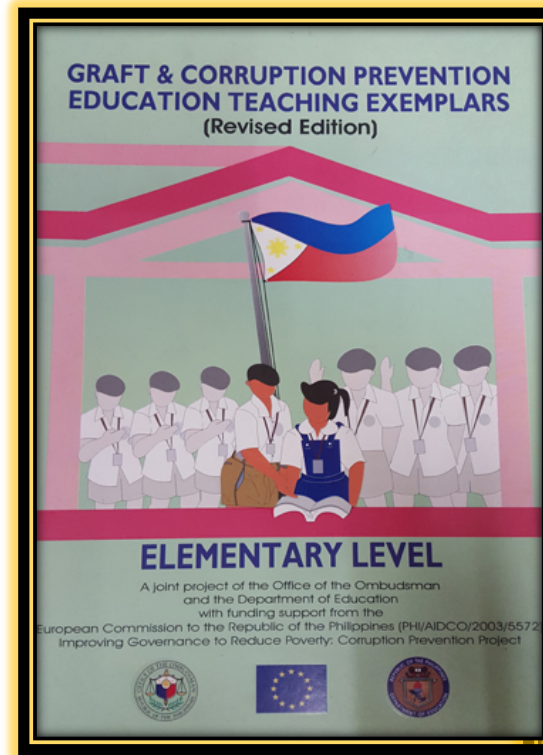
Department of Education (DepEd)

- Issued Memorandum No. 237 Series of 2007, to ensure the integration and effective utilization of the Teaching Exemplars.



JANUARY TO OCTOBER 2015 MONITORING

- 946 pupils/students (Target: 500 pupils/students) in the National Capital Region (NCR) were taught using the Teaching Exemplars.
- 17 schools (Target: 15 schools) in the NCR have integrated the Teaching Exemplars in various subjects.

- Non-partisan school-based youth organizations recognized in their respective schools, which the Office of the Ombudsman accredits.
- Requirement for accreditation: is the submission of an integrity promotion activity implementable within a given school year; with a teacher-adviser.

INTEGRITY, TRANSPARENCY and ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM (ITAP)

- A training program that can be adapted to respond and address the specific need of its target audience, be it appointive, elective, or regular public servants including private individuals.
- Through the National Integrity Center, Office of the Ombudsman a total of 898 public servants in the NCR were trained on the New Government Procurement Reform Act (RA No. 9184) between January and October 2015.



- The National Integrity Center (NIC) of the Office of the Ombudsman spearheads the ITAP implementations and other lectures, seminars, workshops, and training programs on integrity and public accountability .
- Hopefully, we would see the transformation of the NIC into the Ombudsman Academy.
