*Case of an accountant of Agricultural Promotion Bank – charge embezzlement. Sentenced to life imprisonment.

- * Regular training for public servants (need-based)
- * TOT (provincial officials)
- * Capacity building program for SIAA new recruits
- * Discussion going on with MOES in incorporating anti-corruption training into compulsory education (high school up to university level)
- * More TOT for central level officials is anticipated in early 2016
